Through your generosity, the Vincentian Community is able to staff and/or support many ministries. Below are examples.

Seeds of Hope



Two of our Vincentian priests, Fathers Joseph Fitzgerald, C.M. and Teodoro Justavino, C.M., are working with the indigenous Ngabe people in the mountain area of western Panama. Their sacramental ministries embrace the poor country people living in 50 or more villages in the region. The people in this rural mountainous area live in extreme poverty. In order to help them become self-sufficient and to improve their living conditions, the priests have started a program called "Seeds of Hope." This program involves the families themselves to make the program a success.

Central to the program is an "organic agricultural project" that involves animal breeding, tool sharing, rain water harvesting systems, family seed loans, and reforestation efforts. Another part of the program is the building of tilapia fish ponds. Many of the "Seeds of Hope" projects have proved very successful. As a consequence, the living conditions of the people have improved.

Fathers Fitzgerald and Justavino thank those who have sent donations supporting this program. They ask that you pray for its continued success. If you would like to contribute to the program, you may send your offering to Our Lady of Angels Association ear-marked "Seeds of Hope Program."
